**10 July – Car share to Trelawnyd
Grid Ref: SJ 090 796 Grade: Difficult - 7.0 Miles**

Save the environment and share the car journey. Park on the A5151 just past Jacksons garden centre. See the Crown Pub on your left, after few yards see the free parking sign on the right, (LL18 6DN). The walk is fairly flat; some inclines on the fields, good all round countryside. About 20 mostly good stiles. Can be muddy so worth your gaiters.

**24 July - Halkyn
Grid Ref: SJ208 711 Grade: Moderate – 6 miles**

From A55, take the Halkyn exit. Follow B5123 over cattle grid. Turn right, signposted library. At the end of the road turn left and park opposite the library/community centre, (CH8 8BU). An eclectic mix of terrain, a few stiles and magnificent views.

**14 August - Thornton Hough
Grid Ref: SJ 303 810 Grade: Moderate – 5.4 Miles**

Park in the centre of Thornton Hough on Smithy Hill by the village hall. The walk takes us across fields and quiet lanes towards Manor Wood and up to Brimstage. The walk is mainly flat with a few stiles.

**28 August – Babell & Caerwys
Grid Ref: SJ 156 735 Grade: Moderate – 5.3 miles**

Park at 'Blend 92 at The Black' (formerly The Black Lion), Babell, (CH8 8PZ). Quiet rural lanes and footpaths, with one steep uphill section. Lunch is available afterwards.

**11 Sept - Nercwys Forest & Bryn Alyn
Grid Ref: SJ 218 593 Grade: Moderate – 5.0 Miles**

From Mold, take Wrexham Street past Alyn school. Turn right (Recycling Centre). Go under flyover and turn right towards Nercwys. After about 2 miles turn left at the cross roads into Ffordd Cae Newydd. After about 1 mile, turn right and the forest car park is up the hill on the left (CH7 4AU). The walk follows forest tracks, field paths and country lanes, several stiles, some inclines and good views.

**25 September – Holywell Racecourse
Grid Ref: SJ 186 741 Grade Difficult – 6 miles**

Park considerately near the Crooked Horn PH Brynford, (CH8 8AX). From Holywell take B5121 to Brynford turning left at the cross roads towards Pentre Halkyn. We explore open common, Pen-y-Ball monument and the 19th C racecourse. Extensive views.

**9 October -Penycloddiau
Grid Ref: SJ 139 668 Grade: Difficult – 6 miles**

From Mold, take the A541 to Nannerch. Turn left into village then take first left up a lane for approximately 2.5 miles, looking for LLangwyfan Forestry car park on the right. Steep climb at the beginning. The levelling out. On a clear day the views over the Vale of Clwyd will be stunning.

**23 October - Llanasa South Loop
Grid Ref: SJ 106 815 Grade: Moderate – 5 miles**

Meet at car park in Llanasa village (CH8 8NB), near Holywell A walk with plenty of views and 20 stiles.
