14 July – Rhewl to Llanynys

Grid Ref: SJ 110 604 Grade: Moderate – 5 miles

Park considerably in Rhewl village (on A525 Ruthin to Denbigh) and assemble for the walk at the Drovers Arms. A flat walk, mostly off-road, with some stiles. On the route is a simple stone church and ancient churchyard.

28 July – Loggerheads to Maeshafn

Grid Ref: SJ 198 626 Grade: Moderate - 6 miles

Meet in the main (pay and display) car park behind the gift shop at Loggerheads Country Park on the A494 Mold to Ruthin Road (CH7 5LH). The circular route goes through Maeshafn, visiting Aberduna Nature Reserve and returns via Big Covert and Cascade Woods.

11 August - Halkyn mountain

Grid Ref: SJ208711 Grade: Moderate 5 miles

From A55 take the Halkyn exit. Follow B5123 over cattle grid. Turn right, signposted Library. At the end of the road park considerably and meet at the library/community centre (CH8 8BU)

25 August – Buckley to Drury Circular

Grid Ref: SJ 284 654 Grade: Moderate 5 miles

Park in Etna Country Park, Globe Way, Buckley. (CH7 3LW) Lovely views across Wirral.

8 September – Bwlchgwyn

Grid Ref: SJ 263 536 Grade: Moderate - 5.5 miles

Park at the War Memorial (LL11 5YQ) in Bwlchgwyn village on the left of the A525 Ruthin to Wrexham Road. Our walk is through Nant-y-frith Woods to Frith returning by a lower path. Gorgeous views.

22 September – River Alyn Circular

Grid Ref: SJ 319 547 Grade: Easy – 4.5 miles

Take the A541 Mold to Wrexham Road and park at the Alyn Waters Country Park Visitor Centre (LL11 4AG), or along either side of the approach road. (£1.00 parking fee.) Rivers and streams, quiet wooded valleys, some road walking.

13 October – Sealand & River Dee

Grid Ref: SJ 352 688 Grade: Moderate – 6 Miles

Park near St Bartholomew's Church (CH1 6BY). From Sealand Road towards Chester, turn left at traffic lights into Seahill Road where the Church is shortly on the left. This very flat walk takes us along the cycle track and returning alongside the River Dee.

27 October – Lloc Circular

Grid Ref: SJ 145 767 Grade Difficult – 6 miles

Start at Lloc (CH8 8RD). From Holywell on the A5026, turn left at the LLoc pub opposite the garage. Pleasant walk through woodland, fields and lanes.
