<p>11 March – Greenfield Valley and the Wales Coastal Path Grid Ref: SJ 197 775 Grade: Difficult - 5.3 miles</p> <p>Meet in the Greenfield Valley car park off A548 (just past speed camera coming from Flint). Industrial heritage and views across the Dee Estuary. 10 stiles, two inclines and it will be muddy. Philip's mobile :- 07505819690</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Walk Leader: Philip</p>
<p>25 March – Llandegla Grid Ref: SJ 196524 Grade: Difficult - 6.5 miles</p> <p>Meet in the village car park opposite the Church (LL11 3AW). Take turning towards Llandegla village from the A5104 about 250m north east of the traffic lights with the A525. This circular walk to Llyn Cyfynwy has about 200m of ascent, follows parts of Offa's Dyke and Tecla's Community Miles Trail before returning past Bod Idris Hall.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Walk Leader: Hazel</p>
<p>8 April - Halkyn mountain Grid Ref: SJ 208 711 Grade: Moderate – 5 miles.</p> <p>From A55, take the Halkyn exit. Follow B5123 over cattle grid. Turn right, signposted library. At the end of the road turn left and park in the library/community centre car park, (CH8 8BU). Magnificent views on a clear day! .</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Walk Leaders: Cris & John H-R</p>
<p>22 April – Hendre South Circular Grid Ref: SJ 196 677 Grade: Moderate - 5 miles</p> <p>Park at Coed y Felin Nature Reserve (CH7 5QE). Take A541 Mold to Denbigh Road. At Hendre, take 1st turning on right after the speed sign, to small car park on left. Some gentle ascents through woodland with views of the Clwydians. 11 good stiles.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Walk Leaders: Dave & Judy</p>

<p>13 May- Chirk Grid Ref: SJ 298 365 Grade: Moderate – 6 miles</p> <p>Take the A483 Wrexham bypass towards Oswestry. At the Halton roundabout, take third exit signed Chirk. At next roundabout take first exit into Chirk Town. Proceed through Chirk until the carpark (LL14 5DG). on the right just before the Poacher's Inn. 8 stiles, one steep incline.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Walk Leaders: Mike & Arthur</p>
<p>27 May - Tree Tops and Bluebells Grid Ref: SJ 252 582 Grade: Moderate/Difficult – 6.0 miles</p> <p>Park within the lines at Treuddyn Village Hall car park, Queen Street (CH7 4LU). Explore country lanes and field paths around Tree Tops Outdoor Activity Centre and to the south of Treuddyn. Perhaps we will see the bluebells and wild garlic this time?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Walk Leader: Geoff</p>
<p>10 June – Chester: River & Meadows Grid Ref: SJ 410 617 Grade: Moderate – 7 miles</p> <p>Park at Eccleston Ferry car park by the Dee (Nearest postcode CH4 9JE). From the A483 take Rake Lane into Eccleston, turn right into Paddock Road and first left to the car park. The walk follows the River Dee through meadows into Chester, and after some road walking through Handbridge, joining the Duke's Drive back to Eccleston. The walk is relatively flat.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Walk Leaders: Sue & Fiona</p>
<p>24 June - Carshare walk - Abergele Grid Ref: SH 945 787 Shorter walk – 6 miles & Longer Walk: 9.3 miles</p> <p>Park near the railway station at Pensarn (LL22 7PW). Both walks start promptly at 10am from the car park in Abergele, and follow similar southern routes away from the coast. The shorter walk going to the Watchtower and the longer walk extending to Tower Hill & Moelfre Isaf.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Walk Leaders: Longer Walk Barry & John W Shorter Walk: Geoff & Heather</p>
