


NEW-HF Walkers

**14 November 2018 – AGM walk - Gwernymynydd
Grid Ref: SJ 221 627 Grade: Moderate – 4.2 Miles**

Park in Gwernymynydd Village Hall car park on the left of the A494 Ruthin Road from Mold. The walk takes us through woods and fields towards Maeshafn. Some inclines and a few stiles. Our 11th AGM follows in the Hall. Please bring a packed lunch, refreshments provided. If you can't make the walk, then you are most welcome to come to the AGM which is expected to start about 12:30pm.

**28 Nov - Greenfield & Estuary
Grid Ref: SJ 197 775 Grade: Moderate - 6 miles**

Park at the lower Greenfield Valley Heritage Park car park, Bagillt Road (CH8 7EP) opposite the car wash and Pangborn factory. A gradual ascent along the Valley onto a higher pastoral section with views of the Dee Estuary, returning on the North Wales Coastal Path. Numerous interesting stiles, and areas of muddy farmland.

**12 December – Christmas Walk and lunch
Grid Ref: SJ 311 561 Grade: Moderate - 4.5 Miles**

Park in the Holly Bush car park in Cefn-y Bedd (LL12 9UD) at the junction of the A541 and B5102 by the railway bridge. The walk is through woods and fields with some slight inclines, and stiles. Walkers (and non-walking members) are welcome to join us following the walk in a meal at the PH at about 1-00pm.

**9 January 2019 – Bickerton Hill
Grid Ref: SJ 509 536 Grade: Moderate - 6.0 Miles**

From Chester, take A41 for about 8 miles until Broxton roundabout. Left onto A534 for a few miles, pass the now closed Sandstone Pub, next right into Long Lane. Second right by Bickerton Church (SY14 8AV), and park on the right in the small National Trust car park. Several gradual inclines and 6 stiles.

**23 January – Flint countryside
Grid Ref: SJ 233 730 Grade: Moderate – 5.6 Miles**

From A55, take Flint exit, left onto Aber Road at traffic lights, 2nd left and park at the end on the wide road near to the entrance of Flint cemetery (CH6 5YA). The walk has mostly fields, foot paths, and one incline but OK. Small amount road walking. Some local history. Good views and plenty of fresh air.

Grid Ref: SJ 176 746 Grade: Moderate – 5.5 Miles**

Park at Holywell Golf Club (CH8 8LQ) furthest from the Clubhouse. An almost level walk to the south of the Clubhouse. Spectacular views of the Clwydian Range. Members might like to join us to celebrate our birthday with a meal after the walk. Non-walking members are also very welcome; we expect to be back at the Clubhouse at about 1-15pm.

Grid Ref: SJ 202 609 Grade: Moderate - 4.2 Miles**

Park considerately in Maeshafen village (CH7 5LR). A woodland walk with good views, 2 flights of steps, one up & one down, very few stiles, and a longish uphill returning to the village
