#### **13 November 2019 – AGM Walk - Gwernymynydd Grid Ref: SJ 221 627 Grade: Moderate – 5 Miles**

Park in Gwernymynydd Village Hall car park on the left of the A494 Mold to Ruthin road. The walk takes us through woods and fields towards Gwernaffield. Some inclines and a few stiles. Our 12<sup>th</sup> AGM follows in the Hall. Please bring a packed lunch, refreshments provided. If you can't make the walk, then you are most welcome to come to the AGM which is expected to start about 12:30pm.

#### **27 November – Chester: River & Meadows Grid Ref: SJ 410 617 Grade: Moderate – 7 miles**

Park at Eccleston Ferry car park by the river (Nearest postcode CH4 9JE). From the A483 take Rake Lane into Eccleston, turn right into Paddock Road and first left to the car park. The walk follows the River Dee through the meadows into Chester, and after some road walking through Handbridge, joins the Duke's Drive back to Eccleston. The walk is relatively flat.

#### **11 December — Christmas Walk Cefn-y-bedd Grid Ref: SJ 311 561 Grade: Moderate – 4.5 Miles**

Park in the Holly Bush PH car park, Cefn-y Bedd at the junction of the A541 and B5102 by the railway bridge. The walk takes us through woods and fields towards Alyn Waters Country Park. Some slight inclines and a few stiles. The pub is open after the walk should you want to celebrate Christmas with other members. Non-walking members are welcome to join us following the walk at about 1-00pm.

#### **25 December 2019 - Christmas Day NO WALK**

#### **8th January 2020 - Caergwrle and Hope Grid Ref: SJ 308 579 Grade: Moderate - 6 miles**

Meet in the free public car park opposite the new Family Health Centre on Hawarden Road (A550) in Hope (LL12 9NL). A flattish walk along roads, tracks, paths and through fields, over the old pack horse bridge then around the lake north of Hope and back via Wat's Dyke path around Caer Estyn. Could be muddy in parts.

#### **22 January – St Dyfnog's Well Llanrhaedr Grid Ref: SJ 082 634 Grade: Moderate – 6.5 miles**

Take the A525 Denbigh to Ruthin road, turning left at pottery on right into Llanrhaedr. Through village and pass the church for approx. 200 yards and park on the old section of road. The walk features historical buildings, and a riverside walk.

#### **12 February - 17<sup>th</sup> Birthday Walk - Britannia Inn Halkyn Grid Ref: SJ 213 713 Grade: Moderate – 4.5 miles**

Park furthest from the entrance to the Britannia Inn, Pentre Road, Halkyn, Holywell (CH8 8BY) located off the A55. The walk explores the valley of Nant-y-Flint and passes the earthworks of Watt's Dyke. Walkers might like to join other walkers in the PH after the walk to celebrate our seventeenth birthday at about 1230.

#### **26 February – Bodfari Grid Ref: SJ 092 700 Grade: Difficult - 5.5 miles**

Take the A541 Mold to Denbigh Road, turning right onto B5429 then right into Dinorben Arms (LL16 4DA) to park in the top car park. The route is steep in parts with 20 odd stiles, mostly in good condition.
